Dear Court Leader,

The National Center for State Courts (NCSC) was founded in 1971 at the urging of the late Chief Justice of the United States Warren E. Burger. For more than 45 years, the NCSC's mission has remained consistent: improving the administration of justice through leadership, research, education, technology and consulting services.

Every other year, the NCSC sponsors the Court Technology Conference (CTC), which is designed to improve court efficiencies and effectiveness by educating court professionals about the latest breakthroughs and best practices in court technology. This year, **CTC 2017 is being held in Salt Lake City, Utah, September 12-14**. We expect the conference to draw more than 1,200 national and international participants. CTC also showcases one of the highest quality court technology exhibit shows available.

CTC provides judges, court administrators, court managers, technologists and others, with two and a half days of professional development, education sessions, and networking. Here's how one attendee explained CTC's value:

NCSC is the only national court organization dedicated to helping the justice system use technology to improve services, reduce costs, and increase accountability. - Registration – \$850 through August 31;
